BULLETIN 2

We have pleasure in sending you Bulletin 2 for the **World Schools Championship Triathlon 2015 under the aegis of ISF** which will take place from 27th May till 2nd June 2015 in Versailles (France).

The championship is organised by the 'Union Nationale du Sport Scolaire' according to International School Sport Federation competition rules.

This bulletin contains further information to that published in Bulletin 1.

The following countries have indicated an interest in taking part in this event: update 8^{th} January 2015

Individual Schools Boys: Estonia, England, France, Germany, Guatemala, Puerto Rico, Russia, Slovakia

Individual Schools Girls: Estonia, England, France, Germany, Guatemala, Puerto Rico, Russia, Slovakia

Individual Selected Boys: Chile, Estonia, France, Puerto Rico, Russia, Slovakia

Individual Selected Girls: Chile, Estonia, France, Puerto Rico, Russia, Slovakia

Selected Mixed: Chile, Chinese Taipei, France, Puerto Rico, Russia, Slovakia

Schools Mixed: Chile, France, Germany, Puerto Rico, Russia, Slovakia

- 1.1. The competition is open both to school teams and selected teams.

 As the championship is 'under the aegis' countries can register selected teams only.

There will be a competition organised in the following categories:

Individual

- school boys A (students born in 1999 and 2000)
- school girls A (students born in 1999 and 2000)
- school boys B (students born in 1997 and 1998)
- school girls B (students born in 1997 and 1998)
- selected boys A (students born in 1999 and 2000)
- selected girls A (students born in 1999 and 2000)
- selected boys B (students born in 1997 and 1998)
- selected girls B (students born in 1997 and 1998)

Relay

- school teams mixed (boys and girls) A (students born in 1999 and 2000)
- school teams mixed (boys and girls) B (students born in 1997 and 1998)
- selected teams mixed (boys and girls) A (students born in 1999 and 2000)
- selected teams mixed (boys and girls) B (students born in 1997 and 1998)

Neither older nor younger triathletes will be accepted!

1/ Individual

Each delegation can enter 1 to 4 boys or 1 to 4 girls per category but maximum 16 participants in total.

A country that enters only one participant can choose in which category this boy or girl starts, 'individual school' representing his or her school or 'individual selected' representing his/her country's school sport.

From 2 participants it depends if these participants are from the same school (school category) or not (selected category).

The host country has the right to participate with 32 participants.

2/ Relay

To participate in the relay, it is mandatory to have participated in the individual competition.

The relay is for mixed teams of 4 triathletes only (2 boys and 2 girls only). Each delegation can enter maximum 4 relay teams.

Each delegation can enter 1 or 2 relay teams in the same category but maximum 4 teams in total.

Countries that want to participate in the relays and do not have 2 boys and 2 girls in the same category can complete the team with triathletes from other participating countries or from the host country (request via bulletin 2 or 3).

These teams will however not be able to win the title.

The host country has the right to participate with 8 teams.



1.2. School teams must provide a document certifying that each student of the team is enrolled at that school from the beginning of the school year.

Students of selected teams must provide a document certifying that they are enrolled in a school in the country which they represent from the beginning of the school year.

- 1.3. Before the start of the Competition each delegation shall present to the Control Commission:
 - payment of the balance owing or proof that this has been paid,
 - for each participant, a passport or official identity card bearing photo, surname, forename, date of birth and nationality,
 - the document certifying that each student of the school team is normally registered at that school from the beginning of the school year and that each triathlete of a selected team is enrolled in a school in the country which he/she represents from the beginning of the school year.

2. Dates

- 2.1. Delegations are to arrive on 27 May 2015.
- 2.2. Delegations are to depart after breakfast on 2 June 2015.
- 2.3. When the distance between Versailles and the capital of a participating country on another continent exceeds 5000 kilometres the delegation may extend their stay by arriving one day earlier or leaving one day later.
- 2.4. The organisation of an extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event) is a matter for the country concerned (exception see item 2.3.).It shall not be the responsibility of the OC.
- 2.5. The organiser will be able to give you information on alternative accommodation in the area for your use outside the period of the World Championship and for those accompanying the delegation.

3. Board, Lodging and Services

- 3.1. The delegations will stay in Appart' City Hotel in Versailles.
- 3.2. Students will be accommodated in 2 to 4 bedded rooms. Adults acting as Heads of Delegation and the ISF delegates, will be accommodated in single rooms. Coaches/teachers will be accommodated in twin bedded rooms.
- 3.3. Breakfast will be served at the hotel restaurant.

 Lunch and dinner will be served at school canteens, on some occasions picnic on the spot.



3.4. Arrival day: lunch and/or dinner (according to arrival time)

Other days: breakfast - lunch - dinner

Departure day: breakfast – lunch or packed meal (according to departure time and to meals on arrival day)

3.5. A medical service will be available throughout the duration of the Championship.

4. General rules

These rules will apply to all teams and participants and will remain fixed for the duration of this World Schools Championship.

- 4.1. The Organising Committee will be responsible for the running and control of the World Schools Championship.
- 4.2. The World Schools Championship is organised according to ISF rules and to current ITU rules.
- 4.3. The Organising Committee will nominate a Control Commission, a Disciplinary Commission and an Appeal Jury. Their responsibilities will be specified in Bulletin 3.

5. Note concerning Bulletin 3

- 5.1. The link to the definitive electronic entry form will be open to participating countries in good time. On this form you will be required to give the following information:
 - a. name of country
 - b. name of the organisation responsible for school sport
 - c. name of head of delegation
 - d. names of teachers / coaches
 - e. names of students
 - f. dates of birth of students
 - g. names of boys and girls school teams' schools
 - h. names of boys and girls selected teams' schools
 - i. names of additional persons
 - j. precise information on travel times
 - k. particular dietary requirements
 - I. special requests
 - m. passport photos

Please have this information available one month before the start of the event.

5.2. The 3rd Bulletin will give you further information about the social-cultural programme, the definitive event programme and the composition of the Control Commission, the Disciplinary Commission and the Appeal Jury.



6. Visa information

Please check if your country needs visa to enter France.

7. Registration

Registration 1 is still open for countries that did not register yet. If your country still intends to participate you must register by return!

The electronic entry registration form 2 (click here) should be duly completed on behalf of the organisation responsible for school sport at the latest by 31st January 2015.

Your username and password to enter ERAS were sent to you when you received bulletin 1.

If you have not yet paid the deposit, you must do so by return.
