The individual triathlon at 2pm on 5 June 2019

With girls or boy, 16 or 18 years old



600m (656,2 yard) to swim
15 km (9,32 miles) by bike
4 km (2,48 miles) running

The relay triathlon in teams at 2pm on 6 June 2019

With 2 girls and 2 boys



300m (328,1 yard) to swim
8km (4,97 miles) by bike
2km (1,24 miles) running
